## **ACADEMIC STANDING**

Students must maintain a minimum GPA to remain in any program. If a student's academic standing falls beneath a satisfactory level they may be required to withdraw. **See our 5W's of Withdrawing postcard or an advisor about withdrawal from courses.** 

## **GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA)**
