Welcome to the University of Alberta, Augustana Campus! We have prepared some information below to help you find your way to campus from the Edmonton International Airport.

AIRPORT WELCOME BOOTH

When you arrive at the Edmonton International Airport, visit the Post-Secondary School Airport Welcome Booth located on the Level 1 (the Arrivals & Baggage Claim level). There will be volunteers there to greet you and provide you with some immediate need-to-know information, such as where to meet for the Augustana Shuttle on August 20 and 21, how to find a taxi, where to find food, and more.

GETTING TO AUGUSTANA CAMPUS FROM THE AIRPORT

OPTION 1: FREE SHUTTLE ON AUGUST 20 & 21

New international students attending Augustana International Student Orientation on August 22 and 23 qualify for FREE shuttle service to Augustana Campus on August 20 and 21.

1. To register for the Augustana Shuttle email your flight details (arrival date, time, and flight number) and preferred shuttle pick-up date (August 20 or 21) and time (12 pm or 6 pm) to augustana@ualberta.ca.
2. Upon arrival at the airport, proceed to baggage claim to pick up your luggage first.
3. Meet at Door 10 on Level 1 (the Arrivals & Baggage Claim level) by 12 pm or 6 pm. The Augustana Shuttle will depart at approximately 12:15 pm and 6:15 pm.

If you are not able to take the Augustana Shuttle please take a taxi to Augustana Campus (see OPTION 2 below).

The 2019 flat rate fare is \$135 for a trip with Airport Taxi

Service to Augustana Campus (Camrose). Confirm the fare with the driver before departing.

New international students will be reimbursed a maximum of \$100 for the cost of a taxi. Please get a receipt from the driver with the date, amount of the fare paid and your name written on the receipt. Beginning August 27 bring your receipt to Corinne in 2-38 Founders' Hall for reimbursement. The deadline to submit a receipt for reimbursement is October 31, 2019.

Make sure that you have sufficient Canadian currency available before hiring a taxi. Automated teller machines and International Currency Exchange (ICE) are located on Level 1 (the Arrivals & Baggage Claim level).

EARLY ARRIVALS

Early arrivals are discouraged. If you arrive prior to move-in on August 20 or 21 (for new international students attending International Student Orientation) or August 25 (for returning students), please plan to stay at a local hotel (see below).


If you will arrive later than August 25 you must contact the Prospective Student Office at augustana@ualberta.ca and inform them of your plans.

Peer Program

Why join the program?

Participating as a Peer is a great way to meet fellow students who are familiar with the University of Alberta, and who want to share their experiences and resources with you. Senior Peers have often faced the same situations and challenges as you, and they can provide casual advice to help you have a successful academic career.

How does the program work?

Throughout the academic year, Senior Peers (mentors) offer social support, assistance, and guidance, through one-on-one meetings, and social activities. They share personal experiences with new international students (mentees) that ease the transition to university.

- Peers are matched with a Senior Peer. Matches are based on your mutual interests.
- Peers meet their Senior Peer for the first time at the official 'Meet & Greet' on **August 28 at 6:00 pm in the Rashmi Bale Learning Commons, 2nd Floor Library.**
- Throughout the semester, Senior Peers stay in contact with their matches and organize events. Events can include going for coffee, playing sports, or joining in potluck dinners (Peers bring their favourite dish to share at a dinner party).
