

Failure in LIS 501: Foundations of Library and Information Studies

LIS 501: Foundations of Library and Information Studies is a core, required course in the MLIS program. All students must take the course in the first semester of their program. The course is intended to provide the broad context for all of the other courses in the program, and is a pre-requisite or co-requisite for the other required core courses, along with many elective courses. A student who fails the course, i.e. earning a final letter grade of C or lower:

- must retake the course and complete it successfully
- will not be able to enrol in courses for which LIS 501 is a pre-requisite
- may take courses for which LIS 501 is a co-requisite with the consent of the instructor
