<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Day 1<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ <i>Introductions</i>◦ <i>Overview of Grantsmanship, goals & objectives/specific aims</i>◦ <i>Assignment – Write goals & objectives, theory, & literature review sections</i>• Day 2<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ <i>Review project goals & objectives/specific aims</i>◦ <i>Research Design</i>◦ <i>Assignment – Write sample description & research design or evaluation plan</i>• Day 3<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ <i>Review research designs /evaluation plans</i>◦ <i>Developing a budget & budget justification</i>◦ <i>Assignment – Develop timeline and budget, write budget justification</i>• Day 4<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ <i>Review timelines and budgets</i>◦ <i>Research Office requirements, biosketch, writing the abstract, letters of support</i>◦ <i>Assignment – proof application, write abstract, complete forms, submit</i>• Day 5 – Present your grant application to the group
