

## Academic Integrity Mandatory Activity

The Faculty of Rehabilitation Medicine and the University of Alberta take academic integrity seriously and want to make sure that you have had an opportunity to learn about what is considered plagiarism and how to avoid participating in this dishonest practice by mistake. The following steps will help you learn more about plagiarism and establish that you have received this information so you are well prepared prior to course assignments.

### Step ONE:

Read *A Guide to Academic Integrity for Graduate Students*, and the one page *Understanding Plagiarism Tip sheet* linked here: [A Guide to Academic Integrity for Graduate Students.pdf](#) or on the shared Rehabilitation Science EClass site. These resources help you clarify what is meant by certain terms and what the University considers to be dishonest behavior.

### Step TWO:

View, at minimum, two online tutorials related to plagiarism. These tutorials are found on the Library website See [Libraries - Academic Integrity](#). Recommended tutorials include 'avoiding plagiarism' and 'what is paraphrasing'. The guide completed at Step One also provides examples and exercises related to paraphrasing.

### Step THREE:

Complete the paraphrasing activity on the Rehabilitation Sciences EClass site (see under policies and procedures section for assignment).

Once you have read the Guide to Academic Integrity, completed the tutorials and submitted the paraphrasing activity (introduced in Step Three and described on the EClass site), please sign and Submit the *Academic Integrity Signature Page* to the Associate Dean, Graduate Studies in the Faculty office (3-48). Once your paraphrasing activity has been viewed and approved by the Associate Dean, they will sign the document and place it in your file. You will be notified of completion of your mandatory academic integrity activities.
