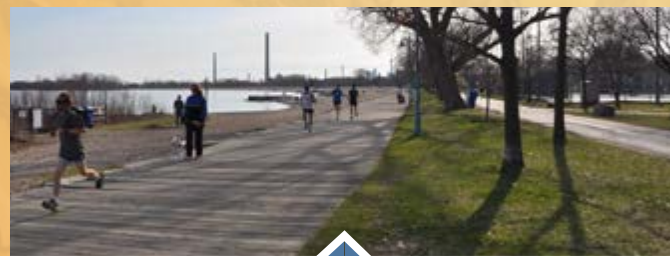

- > Optional 4, 8, 12 or 16-month paid Work Experience

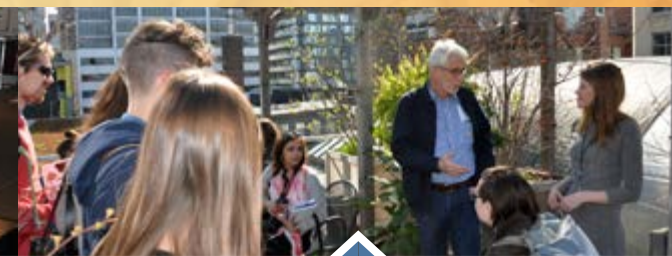


BA MAJOR
