

# Tax Return Supporting Documents

Updated February 2019

The supporting document checklist varies each individual student's situation. This list includes the most common required supporting documents. **Not every document may be applicable for your tax return.**

1. T4 Form (Statement of Remuneration) – this form indicates your income and your income deductions to the government. You can receive this form from your employer.
2. T4A Form (Taxable Scholarship) - Your scholarship income. This form will be mailed to you.
3. T2202A Form - Your tuition and education costs. You can download or print this form from Beartracks.
4. T5 Form - Identifies the amount of interest you received from a financial institution and will be mailed to you.
5. Public Transportation Receipts. U-Pass holders can download or print this receipt from Beartracks.
6. Charitable Donation Receipts (must be a registered Charity).
7. Social Insurance Number (SIN). If you are not eligible to obtain a SIN, you need to apply for an Individual Tax Number. Visit International Services Centre for more information.
8. If you have completed a tax return in Canada previously, bring your previous "Notice of Assessment" form.
9. Any additional tax slips you may have.

After you obtain all forms you can start to complete a tax return.
