GPS is pleased to announce details of the 2026/27 Graduate Course-Based Master's Community Engagement Award funded by the Faculty of Graduate & Postdoctoral Studies (GPS). This award recognizes the academic achievement and demonstrated leadership, community engagement, volunteerism of course-based master's students at the University of Alberta.

General Process:

Students cannot apply directly to GPS for this competition. Students must consult their faculty for the faculty's internal application process and deadlines.

Each faculty is assigned a funding allocation by GPS, and then selects nominees based on those allocations. Faculties may determine the best way to select their nominees and are encouraged to set an earlier internal deadline to allow time for internal adjudication (if applicable). The faculty then nominates students to GPS.

Nomination Process:

A complete nomination package includes the following documents and must be uploaded as a separate PDF document to each designated file section in the GSMS Portal; ***please do not upload duplicate documents:***

1. [**Graduate Course-Based Master's Community Engagement Award Application Form**](#) – must be written and signed by the student.
2. **Up-to-date Unofficial U of A Transcript** - printed from Bear Tracks; must include current registration (i.e. Fall 2026)

GSMS Awards Portal Submission Deadline: Monday, November 2, 2026

Faculties must submit their nominations to GPS via the GSMS Awards Portal by the above deadline. Faculties may submit nominations for processing prior to the stipulated deadline and GPS will endeavour to process them early.

As part of the nomination submission, we ask faculties to also keep a record of how many award applications they received from each of their departments.
